**SUBJECT:** Mileage Rates Effective January 1, 2010

Section 81-1176 provides that Administrative Services shall set the mileage rate to be used in reimbursing State employees for use of a personal vehicle in conducting State business.

Effective January 1, 2010 the standard mileage rate will be **decreased** to 50¢ from the current rate of 55¢. All other information regarding personal vehicle mileage remains the same, and can be found at:

Effective January 1, 2010 the mileage rates associated with employee moving/relocation expense will be **decreased** to 50¢ from the current rate of 55¢. The first 16.5¢ (compared to 24¢ per mile in 2009) is considered non-taxable income; any amount over 16.5¢ per mile must be treated as a non-qualified moving expense and is considered taxable income.
