Bi-weekly payroll was processed last Thursday and scheduled for payment on Wednesday, October 7<sup>th</sup>. It is estimated that as a group, we process a total of just over 12,400 payrolls each bi-weekly pay period. I received the warrant count this morning. There were 44 warrants printed in total. 42 of them were as a result of the last paycheck to summer help. **There were only 2 stray warrants issued.** Both of those were the result of last minute changes to the deposit account number and overlooking the resulting pre-note flag.

The monthly payroll processes this week, Thursday, and we are expecting 100% of the payroll going to direct deposit.
