Following are the questions submitted and answers provided for the above mentioned Invitation to Bid. The questions and answers are to be considered as part of the Invitation to Bid.

QUESTIONS	ANSWERS
1. Images must be time-stamped and GPS-tagged in a format compatible with the current NDOR network browser. Please supply full specifications of the image metadata format that is required by the current NDOR network browser.	See Appendix "D". The current browser vendor has committed to assist in any data compatibility issues.
2. Downward images must be compatible with NDOR browser. Please supply full specifications of the downward image format that is required by the current NDOR network browser.	See Appendix "D". The current browser vendor has committed to assist in any data compatibility issues.
3. Is it mandatory requirement that the downward pavement images need to be in color?	Yes
4. Is there a specific chassis make and model that NDOR would prefer that meets both the one ton weight requirement and minimum of 63 inches headliner height requirement?	No
5. Is there an external height restriction for chassis?	Maximum height of 9'-0"
6. The "Vendor must be able to provide software and hardware support for the life of the vehicle." Please define "life of the vehicle" in years.	The vendor must be able to provide software and hardware support for the period of time NDOR has the system and vehicle in service. The units being replaced are 2005 model year.

<p><b>7.</b> The Invitation to Bid document asks for a vendor number. Is this required? If so, how do we obtain a vendor number?</p>	<p>Any firm or individual bidding on a State of Nebraska Invitation to Bid does not need to be registered as a vendor with the State Purchasing Bureau. However, awarded bidder(s) not registered with State Purchasing Bureau will be required to complete a "Vendor Application" form prior to any contract or purchase order award. <p><b>8.</b> Should the bidder include its standard warranty language applicable to the optional extended service agreement? Or, will this be discussed and negotiated after a vendor is selected?</p>	<p>The bidder should state what their extended service would provide and an estimated cost, if they so choose to bid this option.</p>
<p><b>9.</b> Is it required that the bidder be registered to conduct business in Nebraska prior to submitting a bid? Or, can the bidder acquire a business license after being selected as the winning bidder?</p>	<p>The vendor is not required to be authorized to transact business in the State of Nebraska prior to submitting a bid. Prior to contract award, potential award recipient(s) will be asked to certify compliance with Nebraska Secretary of State Registration by providing a true and exact copy of current (dated within 90 days) valid Certificate of Good Standing or Letter of Good Standing. This must be accomplished prior to the award of the contract.</p>
