QUESTIONS	ANSWERS
<p>1. Can you tell us what Line 8 D-3 Alternate Material Mix #1 is? Also Line 9 D-3 Alternate Material Mix #2 is? Does this allow for the substitution of another material in lieu of SPR?</p>	<p>The Nebraska Department of Roads (NDOR) used SPR as a general standard of asphaltic concrete material in the specification. However, this ITB is not limited to that specific mix. NDOR is requesting vendors submit bids for SPR <b>and/or</b> bids for alternate material mixes. It is not the intent of NDOR to request any special mixes or require any vendor to produce any type of asphaltic concrete that is not already part of normal production. Alternate bids will be accepted for consideration as long as mix type information is included with the submitted bid; to include product specifications, mix design data and binder type. It is the intent of NDOR to award multiple contracts for asphaltic concrete.</p>
<p>2. Do all of the tons for each area go to one specific location or is there a breakout of where the tons will go?</p>	<p>This ITB is written for pick up by districts, no deliveries of material will be made. The quantities listed on the ITB are estimates of what that designated district <i>might</i> utilize in a contract year but no material is requested to be made specific for NDOR.</p>
