Following are the questions submitted and answers provided for the above mentioned Invitation to Bid. The questions and answers are to be considered as part of the Invitation to Bid.

QUESTIONS	ANSWERS
1. in item #1 Question about the last sentence. Does the state really have the right to return the product for ANY reason without any costs or fees? With this statement written in the bid, we will not be placing a bid for this ITB, or any other ITB that have this statement included in the bid. It is an unfair burden placed on the seller to be required to accept a return for any reason or fees. It would drive us out of business if all customers did this.	Please see <b>revised specification</b> , Item 1, Quality below.
2. Section 5. C. Loader to have an auxiliary high flow hydraulic circuit to operate the stated attachments. System flow requirement to be 36 to 40 gpm @ 3000 psi or 32 to 40 gpm @ 4000 psi. Is 34 gpm at 3,450 psi acceptable?. This equals a hydraulic hp of 67hp.	34 gpm at 3,450 psi is acceptable.

QUESTIONS	ANSWERS
3. Section 6. D. Muffler required. If the machine is final Tier 4 and has a DOC Filter in place of the muffler is this acceptable? With this filter a muffler is no needed.	A final Tier 4 with a DOC filter in place of a muffler is acceptable.
4. 7. A. Electric starter with key type ignition required. Is a push button start option acceptable if it come's in a package that offers: Keyless Start (Sealed Switch Module), Switchable control patterns between ISO and H, Selectable propel aggressiveness, Creeper Mode, Boom and Bucket speed settings, 12V 3 Pin and 14 Pin Attachment Control Harness, Anti Theft Lockout System?	A push button start is acceptable but it must be pass code/word protected.
5. 11. M. Approved brands of planer are Bobcat and Coneqtec. Can RoadHog/Zanetis belisted as an approved brand? We brought a 40" Planer in last year and tested it with Bud VanCleve's group out of Fremont and Doug Schulz down on Superior. We received no negative feedback during the demo's and would like to be considered an acceptable option for a Planer.	The RoadHog/Zanetis will be an acceptable brand of planer.
6. I have a life cycle cost question. On line 6 "life cycle cost form" Bid Price listed on bid line 1. This number includes the Brush Cutter and planner on lines 8&9. Can we deduct lines 8&9 off line 1 for the life cycle cost formula? It is very difficult to find resell values of these attachment's.	List the life cycle cost for the machine only and do not include the Brush Cutter and Planer.
7. Question: (Refer to Brush Cutter 10. D) Would it be acceptable to have 4 swing out type cutting blades?	4 swing out type cutting blades is acceptable.

**Item 1, QUALITY** on Page 4 of 12 of the Specifications is hereby replaced and superseded in its entirety by the following:

Product quality must meet specifications and be consistent for the term of the contract. A guarantee of satisfactory performance by the supplier and meeting delivery dates are considered to be an integral part of the purchase contract resulting from this bid invitation. All materials must be of first quality, under standard production by the manufacturer and be of standard design, complete as

regularly advertised and marketed and be of proven performance. Products are to be fully guaranteed and may be returned for full credit or replacement (at the State's option) for any reason during the initial warranty period with no additional charges for shipping or restocking.

This addendum will become part of the bid and should be acknowledged with the ITB.
