QUESTIONS	ANSWERS
1. <b>Section 4. Performance Criteria – Part B</b> – Can you please give more detail to the request of what will be required for the Performance Studies required?	Vendor shall supply documents showing the unit has met all requirements in 4.A. 1 and 2.
2. <b>Section 4. Performance Criteria – Part C</b> – Some Trailer Towed units do not require the use of cartridges. Is it OK to answer No & Provide Alternative with detail noting our unit does not require cartridges? Or may we suggest the language be modified to accept all NCHRP 350 TL-3 Approved Truck Towed Attenuators?	NDOR has found attenuators with replacement cartridge(s) are the best fit for their application, due to replacement cost concerns in the event of accidents. The specifications will remain as written.
3. <b>Section 5. Components – Part A 2.</b> – Some Truck Towed units do not require the use of cartridges. May we suggest the language be modified to say “Trailer should be replaceable cartridge(s) design <b>OR approved alternative.</b>	NDOR has found attenuators with replacement cartridge(s) are the best fit for their application, due to replacement cost concerns in the event of accidents. The specifications will remain as written.

<p><b>4. Section 5. Components – Part E. –</b>  Some Truck Towed units do not require “hydraulic”. May we suggest the language be modified to say “<b>Where applicable</b>, the hydraulic system shall be designed to allow.....”. Our trailer is “Anti-Rotational by design and does not require the addition of hydraulics.</p>	<p>NDOR requires the hydraulic system for safety reasons. The specifications will remain as written.</p>
<p><b>5. On Page one: NEBRASKA CONTRACTOR AFFIDAVIT:</b> Bidder hereby attests that bidder is a Nebraska Contractor. “Nebraska Contractor” shall mean any bidder who has maintained a bona fide place of business and at least one employee within this state for at least six(6) months immediately preceding the posting date of this ITB.</p> <p>Does this mean that a bid from a vendor outside of Nebraska will not be accepted?</p>	<p>This information is for statistical purposes only and will not be considered for Contract award purposes. The State of Nebraska will be accept bid(s) from other state vendors.</p>
