2. Is it need to also provide RFID INJECTABLE TRANSPONDER? Or the tags just need to match the RFID INJECTABLE TRANSPONDER? (sic)	There is no injectable transponder involved or allowed.
3. Do you have any photo for the bags? (sic)	No. See <a href="http://www.aphis.usda.gov/traceability/downloads/ADT_device_ain.pdf">http://www.aphis.usda.gov/traceability/downloads/ADT_device_ain.pdf</a> for photos of tags.
4. Is bidder need to hold any license for these products?	The manufacturer and the product must have gone through an evaluation and approval process with USDA and be authorized to manufacture, market and distribute the specific authorized product.  See ITB 4766 OF, clauses "USDA Authorized Dealer" and "USDA Approval."
5. Could you accept products made in China?	Please see the answer to question #4 above.

With regard the invitation to bid, one time purchase Solicitation Number 4766 OF, the requirements are for the state Identification code (NE) and the uppercase letters VAC be printed on the face of the ear tag. With the size of the RFID tags and USDA regulations for size of print of the tag number, a 2D barcode this will make it very difficult to get these requirements on the tags face surface. We have seen in many other states where the male button that attaches the tag to the ear is used to not only etch these same indices but also to comply with USDA regulations with the etching of "Do Not Remove." Will this be permissible in compliance for this ITB?</p>	<p>Bidders may submit alternative bids at their discretion. The State reserves the right to review and consider alternative bids.</p>
