<p>1. Pg 12, Evidence of Coverage: "The contractor should furnish the State, with their proposal response, a certificate of insurance coverage" Is an evidence of coverage sufficient? Our insurance provider won't issue a certificate of coverage UNLESS a contract has been awarded and executed.</p>	<p>A certificate of insurance coverage is not a mandatory requirement to bid on 4848 Z1. A certificate of insurance coverage will be required, per the insurance requirements of the RFP, of the bidder who is the recipient of a Letter of Intent to Contract and the certificate of insurance coverage must be provided before a contract award can be executed.</p>
<p>2. Your response to question 32 in the 1st round of questions was "50 gallon and/or larger Rubbermaid or equivalent containers on wheels (Provided by Contractor)." Does this include the large trash trucks that are located in freight elevator lobby and taken to the loading dock each night? If so, how many are needed?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can 44 gallon Rubbermaid containers be used instead of the 50 gallon units? 	<p>The contractor is not responsible for purchasing the large trash trucks; these are owned by the State.</p> <p>Yes, 44 gallon containers and/or larger Rubbermaid or equivalent containers on wheels (Provided by Contractor) are acceptable.</p>
