<p><b>1.</b> Do you recognize minority owned businesses? If so, what special consideration is given to minority owned?</p>	<p>The State of Nebraska does not give special consideration to minority owned business.</p>
<p><b>2.</b> Please define your fixed price request. Auctioneer services are typically bid by percentage of gross sale total. Is this an acceptable method?</p>	<p>No. The State cannot enter into a contingent fee contract, per Neb. Rev. §73-203. Fees must be provided as a specific dollar amount in conjunction with the gross sales break points as designated on Form D Proposed Fee Schedule.</p>
<p><b>3.</b> Are any additional fees allowed to be assessed by the auction company to the State, or the buyers?</p>	<p>No. All fees must be provided as a specific dollar amount in conjunction with the gross sales break points as designated on Form D Proposed Fee Schedule.</p>

<p>4. We have seen similar language requests for the City of Lincoln proposal. The bid was awarded to a contractor that stated "price is negotiable" in their bid. Will you accept a bid with those parameters?</p>	<p>No.</p>
<p>5. A Nebraska Auto Auction Dealer license is required to conduct the auctions. Our company has had one in the past and it can be reinstated quickly. Are we required to have a valid license to submit the bid, or can we provide a letter of intent to reinstate that license once we have been accepted?</p>	<p>The license is not required to submit a bid. The license will be required to finalize contract award per Neb. <p>6. Will this bid be based on best price, or best value?</p>	<p>The RFP is based on Cost Only.</p>
<p>7. We conduct many live simulcast auctions around the state and have found that the live simulcast auction significantly impacts the gross auction results. Will bids that provide a simulcast environment be given preference to bids that only provide a live auction?</p>	<p>No. The RFP will be evaluated on Cost Only.</p>
