1. What shape is the beach float? We understand it to be 12", but is it round, oval, oblong?	The beach float is in the shape of an oval.
2. What sort of attachments should it include?	Cable clamp, one on each side is the type of attachment.
3. Does it have pipe through the center?	There is a ½ inch schedule 40 PVC pipe through the float.
4. Can you provide a part number of item description from a manufacturer that has provided this product to you in the past or that you know produces this product?	The part number from Patterson Medical Supply is #B1130BO.

Will this buoy be accepted as equal or superior to the "12x51 Can Buoy" specified in the invitation to bid?</p>	<p>The State will not review or approve products before the bid opening. Please submit a bid for products that meet or exceed specifications.</p>
<p>7. For the "Beach Float 12" we would like to offer SL-B18BF Barrier Float. (See attached spec sheet.) Will this float be accepted as equal or superior to the "Beach Float 12" specified in the invitation to bid?</p>	<p>The State will not review or approve products before the bid opening. Please submit a bid for products that meet or exceed specifications.</p>
