"We can do it, however some of the requirement is too strict, such as the delivery time, if each shipment is only 2 pieces of the license plate, then the price will be high because of the courier fee from China to US. the best way is your department ordering the empty brass plate which is produced without the name, time and license no. in 1 times for a year, then finding a local laser engraving workshop, then everything will be easier. all in all 1 solicitation becomes 2 ones."	Per our specifications, the vendor is to obtain the brass plates, provide a secure storage facility for the Lifetime Permit plates, maintain an inventory of plates, notify the Agency when plates need to be re-ordered, engrave plates and delivery within 72 hours. These services are to be provided by one vendor.
