<p><b>1.</b> RFP Section Terms and Conditions Page # 32 XX</p> <p>Question: Does the Disaster Recovery /Back-up Plan need to be submitted in the original submission, or is it requested after the " Intent to Contract" ?</p>	<p>The State requires the Contractor to have a disaster recovery or back-up plan however the plan does not need to be submitted unless requested by the State.</p>

<p><b>2.</b> RFP Section II Procurement Procedures Page #7 M</p> <p>Question: Exactly what certificate or documentation is required to be submitted with original submission? Does your bank provide the "Good Standing" letter?</p>	<p>The bidders <b>may</b> submit either the Letter of Good Standing or Certificate of Good Standing with the proposal response. The Letter or Certificate is not a requirement of the proposal response.</p> <p>The contractor <b>must</b> submit either the Letter of Good Standing or Certificate of Good Standing before entering into a contract with the State. The Letter or Certificate is required from the contractor.</p> <p>The Letter of Good Standing or Certificate of Good Standing can be obtained by the Contractor after registering with the Nebraska Secretary of State.</p>
<p><b>3.</b> What if weather does not permit us to get done in the allotted time?</p>	<p>It is required for the Contractor to complete the project by March 15, 2016. The renewal period of forty-five (45) days is optional.</p> <p>The State reserves the right to extend the period of this contract beyond the termination date when <u>mutually</u> agreeable to the Contractor and the State of Nebraska.</p>
<p><b>4.</b> What if we get high water that for some reason does not allow us to get to the job done?</p>	<p>Refer to Question 3.</p>
<p><b>5.</b> What if the job is not completed by April 1st?</p>	<p>Refer to Question 3.</p>
