IV.A.7	27	What is the minimum number of trees per pile?	<p>Due to variable tree sizes, it is difficult to give a minimum number of trees per pile. However, tree piles are needed to be consolidated as much as possible under the direction of the area biologist.</p> <p>Example – 25 trees per pile</p> <p>Please also see question 1</p>
