Following are the questions submitted and answers provided for the above mentioned Request for Proposal. The questions and answers are to be considered as part of the Request for Proposal.

Questions	Answers
1. What items will be disposed of in the compactor at the Cornhusker State Industries (CSI) shops?	The CSI shops use the Correctional Facility's compactor to compact their waste. Sewing Shop #16 use trash containers for bags of scrap material and trash such as paper towels and daily consumption. Woodshop #29 use containers paper towels, stain rags and cans, daily consumption waste, wood dust shavings, and unused wood fall off.
2. What type/size compactor are you looking for at the CSI shops?	None needed.
3. Are you requesting new equipment at the CSI shops?	Just containers to hold waste per specifications
4. How often to anticipate hauling the compactor from the CSI shops?	Compactor will not be hauled. Containers used to hold waste will be hauled per each facility's needs.
5. Do you own the compactor at the Omaha Correctional Center?	Yes
6. Are we required to take material in containers to a specific landfill?	No specific landfill has been specified.
7. The bid document states that we need to provide landfill tickets with tonnage of materials...we will be picking up your front load containers in combination with other containers, we will not be able to calculate your tonnage on these containers. Is this acceptable? (We will be able to calculate tonnage on all larger roll off containers.)	In the past, the only tonnage charged has been for landfill fees for the 40 yard compactor / receiver. The service was billed at a flat or monthly rate.
