1	VI	25	<p>What is the basis for awarding this contract as all Category A3 products have a different price point along with addition rate? Product A could cost \$3.75 a gallon delivered, with a 10% addition rate to salt brine resulting in a finished price of \$.375 a gallon compared to Product B with a \$1.95 per gallon delivered price with a 30% addition rate resulting in a finished price of \$.585 a gallon. Product A could be eliminated due to the higher delivered price per gallon but could provide a long-term cost savings or would Product B be selected since the delivered cost per gallon is less but long-term cost more money to use?</p>	<p>The State of Nebraska may consider, but is not limited to considering, one or more of the following award criteria: 1) Price; 2) Location; 3) Quality; 4) Delivery time; 5) Bidder qualifications and capabilities; and 6) State contract management requirements and/or costs.</p> <p>Furthermore, the resulting contract(s) may not be exclusive as the State reserves the right to contract for the same or similar goods from other sources now or in the future.</p>
