**The original RFP said "Wireless or Wi-Fi will not be allowed" (Page 57, P). We are making the following changes:**

General rules for wireless:

- 1) All permanent kiosks should be hardwired with Cat6 unless there are special circumstances, example OCC housing units with kiosk mounted on railing. The vendor is responsible for all cabling from the vendor's kiosk/video unit to the State's network switch in the communications room. This will require conduit and raceway work in some cases.
- 2) Portable kiosk/video units will be wireless in most cases. This applies to most but not all segregation and control units.
- 3) NDCS provides wireless service in a few areas of the facilities. The State will provide all wireless service for this project. The vendor will not be allowed to install their own wireless access points due to OCIO requirements. The vendor must still install the Cat6 cabling from the State's network switch to the State's WAP. The facility security administrator will help decide locations of WAPs.

**WAN service changes**

Contractors will provide their own WAN services by contacting local providers. Contractor will plug the ISP's WAN equipment into the State's equipment via a switch port or firewall port the State will provide.

If contractor can't reasonably provide WAN services, NDCS can still provide the 2Mb and additional Mb is negotiable.
