Questions	Answers
1. Can the evaluation criteria and weighting be provided prior to proposal opening?	The RFP indicates that evaluation criteria will not be released prior to the proposal opening event.
2. Will existing or current contracts with the State have any effect on the selection / awarding of contractors?	No.
3. Who are/were the incumbents for the current/previous contract that provided similar services?	This information is not necessary for completion of a response to the RFP.
4. Will subcontractor experience be weighted any differently than prime contractor experience?	See response to question #1.
5. What was the awarded dollar value of the last similar contract?	The current contract award amounts total \$2,425,000.
6. What is the anticipated contract dollar capacity for this contract?	See response to question #5.
7. What are the sources of the contract funding?	State and federal funding.
8. What programs would this contract support?	See RFP Section IV.A.4.a, page 44.
9. What were the most common types of programs supported under the last contract?	Site assessments.
10. What were the most common types of projects awarded under the last contract?	Site assessments.
11. Has lack of funding resulted in the termination of contract(s) in previous contract periods?	No.
