3. Any Addenda and or Amendments to include Questions and Answers;
4. Warranty documents supplied with the bid;
5. The contract award.

Unless otherwise specifically stated in a contract amendment, in case of any conflict between the incorporated documents, the documents shall govern in the following order of preference with number 1 receiving preference over all other documents and with each lower numbered document having preference over any higher numbered document: 1) the contract award, 2) ITB addenda or amendments, to include Questions and Answers, with the latest dated amendment having the highest priority, 3) the original ITB, 4) the signed ITB Contract document, 5) warranty documents supplied with the bid.

STANDARD CONDITIONS AND TERMS OF BID SOLICITATION AND OFFER Invitations to Bid and Contract Awards

It is the responsibility of the bidder to check the website for all information relevant to this solicitation to include addenda and/or amendments issued prior to the opening date. Website address: <http://www.das.state.ne.us/materiel/purchasing/purchasing.htm>

SCOPE- These standard conditions and terms of bid solicitation and acceptance apply in like force to this inquiry and to any subsequent contract resulting therefrom.

PRICES- Prices quoted shall be net, including transportation and delivery charges fully prepaid by the bidder, F.O.B. destination named in the Invitation to Bid. No additional charges will be allowed for packing, packages or partial delivery costs. When an arithmetic error has been made in the extended total, the unit price will govern.

EXECUTION- Bids must be signed in ink by the bidder on the State of Nebraska's Invitation to Bid form. All bids must be typewritten or in ink on the State of Nebraska's Invitation to Bid form. Erasures and alterations must be initialed by the bidder in ink. No telephone or voice bids will be accepted. Failure to comply with these provisions may result in the rejection of the bid.

FACSIMILE DOCUMENTS- The State Purchasing Bureau will only accept facsimile responses to Invitations to Bid on bids under \$25,000 and up to ten (10) pages. However, two party sealed bids containing facsimile pages are acceptable. No direct facsimile solicitation responses will be accepted for a commodity contract.

VALID BID TIME- Bids shall be firm for a minimum of sixty (60) calendar days after the opening date, unless otherwise stipulated by either party in the Invitation to Bid.

DISCOUNTS- Prices quoted shall be inclusive of ALL trade discounts. Cash discount terms of less than thirty (30) days will not be considered as part of the bid. Cash discount periods will be computed from the date of receipt of a properly executed claim voucher or the date of completion of delivery of all items in a satisfactory condition, whichever is later.

PAYMENT- Payment will be made by the responsible agency in conjunction with the State of Nebraska Prompt Payment Act 81-2401 through 2408. The State may request that payment be made electronically instead of by state warrant.

COLLUSIVE BIDDING- The bidder guarantees that the prices quoted have been arrived at without collusion with other eligible bidders and without effort to preclude the State of Nebraska from obtaining the lowest possible competitive price.

LUMP SUM OR ALL OR NONE BIDS- The State reserves the right to purchase item-by-item, by groups or as a total when the State may benefit by so doing. Bidders may submit a bid on an "all or none" or "lump sum" basis but should also submit a bid on an item-by-item basis. The term "all or none" means a conditional bid which requires the purchase of all items on which bids are offered and bidder declines to accept award on individual items; a "lump sum" bid is one in which the bidder offers a lower price than the sum of the individual bids if all items are purchased but agrees to deliver individual items at the prices quoted.

SPECIFICATIONS- Any manufacturer's names, trade names, brand names, information and/or catalog numbers listed in a specification are for reference and not intended to limit competition, but will be used as the standard by which equivalent material offered will be judged. The State Purchasing Director will be the sole judge of equivalency. The bidder may offer any brand which meets or exceeds the specification. When a specific product is required, the Invitation to Bid will so state. Any item bid is to be the latest current model under standard production at the time of order. No used or refurbished equipment will be accepted, unless otherwise stated.

ALTERNATE/EQUIVALENT BIDS- Bidder may offer bids which are at variance from the express specifications of the Invitation to Bid. The State reserves the right to consider and accept such bids if, in the judgement of the State Purchasing Director, the bid will result in goods and/or services equivalent to or better than those which would be supplied in the original bid specifications. Bidders must indicate on the Invitation to Bid the manufacturer's name, number and shall submit with their bid, sketches, descriptive literature and/or complete specifications. Reference to literature submitted with a previous bid will not satisfy this provision. Bids which do not comply with these requirements are subject to rejection. In the absence of any stated deviation or exception, the bid will be accepted as in strict compliance with all terms, conditions and specifications, and the bidder shall be held liable therefore.

SAMPLES- When requested, samples shall be furnished at the bidders expense prior to the opening of the bid, unless otherwise specified. Each sample must be labeled clearly and identify the bidders name, the Invitation to Bid number and the item number. Samples submitted must be representative of the commodities or equipment which would be delivered if awarded the bid. The State of Nebraska reserves the right to request samples even though this may not have been set forth in the Invitation to Bid. Samples not destroyed in testing will be returned at bidders expense, if requested, or will be donated to a public institution.

RECYCLING- Preference will be given to items which are manufactured or produced from recycled material or which can be readily reused or recycled after their normal use as per State Statute Section 81-15,159.

LATE BIDS- All bids will be time and date stamped upon receipt by the State Purchasing Bureau, and this shall be the official time and date of receipt. Bids received after the time of the bid opening will be considered late bids and will be returned to the bidder unopened. The State Purchasing Bureau is not responsible for late bids or lost requests due to mail service inadequacies, traffic or other similar reasons.

BID OPENING- Openings shall be public on the date and time specified on the Invitation to Bid form. It is the bidder's responsibility to assure the bid is delivered at the designated date, time and place of the bid opening. Telephone bids are not acceptable. A bid may not be altered after opening of the bids.

NO BID- If not submitting a bid, respond by returning the Invitation to Bid form explaining the reason in the space provided. Failure to respond to an Invitation to Bid may be cause for the removal of the bidder's name from the mailing list. NOTE: To qualify as a respondent, bidder must submit a "NO BID" and it must be received no later than the stated bid opening date and time.

AWARD- All purchases, leases, or contracts which are based on competitive bids will be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder, determined according to the provisions of State Statute Section 81-161, R.R.S. 1943. The State reserves the right to reject any or all bids, wholly or in part and to waive any deviations or errors that are not material, do not invalidate the legitimacy of the bid and do not improve the bidders competitive position. All awards will be made in a manner deemed in the best interest of the State.




SCOPE

The intent of these requirements, which are in addition to those on the Invitation to Bid Form, Standard Conditions and Terms of the Bid Solicitation and Offer, is to establish a contract between the State of Nebraska and an acceptable vendor to **SUPPLY AND DELIVER GROCERY PRODUCTS** to the Department of Health and Human Services, Department of Correctional Services and Game and Parks Commission.

NON-COMPLIANCE STATEMENT

Read this specification carefully. Any and all exceptions to this specification must be written on or attached to quotation request. Non-compliance can void your quotation.

TERMS OF CONTRACT

This contract is in effect for a period from September 1, 2010 through August 31, 2011. The State reserves the right to extend the period of this contract beyond the termination date when mutually agreeable to the vendor and the State of Nebraska.

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

No interpretation related to the meaning of bid specifications or other pre-bid documents will be made orally to any Bidder by the State of Nebraska. Any request for bid interpretation must be put in writing and faxed by the Bidder to: State Purchasing Bureau, 301 Centennial Mall South, PO Box 94847, Lincoln, NE 68509, Fax (402) 471-2089 (Inquiries received within 48 hours of bid opening may not be addressed).

RIGHTS

Any resulting contract is an exclusive right to provide the type of supplies and services enumerated herein, except in those cases where a vendor cannot perform on an occasional basis, the State reserves the right, through the State Purchasing Bureau, to purchase items necessary for emergency needs. The State also reserves the right to participate in occasional "Opportunity Buys" that become available for contracted items when it is in the best interest of the State of Nebraska. The official Order Guide will be considered part of the contract document.

The State reserves the right to reject any and all bids, wholly or in part, to waive any technicality in any bid, to make awards in a manner deemed in the best interest of the State and, unless otherwise specified by the bidder, to accept any item in the bid.

CANCELLATION

This contract is subject to cancellation by either party upon 60 days written notice.

In the event a vendor fails to perform in good faith and in accordance with the terms of the contract, and cannot furnish good and sufficient cause for failure to perform, the contract shall be terminated, with the State of Nebraska providing 60 days notice to the vendor, in writing. Written notice shall be given to the vendor stating complete cause for termination

action. Circumstances such as strikes and/or fire over which the vendor has no control will not be considered sufficient cause for termination.

BREACH OF CONTRACT

In case of default of the contractor to deliver goods within delivery time specified, the State may procure articles from other sources and hold the contractor responsible for any excess cost occasioned hereby.

AUDIT REQUIREMENTS:

All Contractor books, records and documents relating to the products supplied under this contract shall be subject to audit at any reasonable time upon the provision of reasonable notice by the State. All records shall be maintained in accordance with generally accepted government accounting principles.

Contractor will be required to certify to the State in writing, on a yearly basis, that it has completed a self-audit of prices and that all contracted items have been billed at contract-awarded prices.

The contract shall also be subject to a quarterly audit by the State. The State may randomly select up to 30 items (or more, at the discretion of the State) off of the contract for which the Contractor shall be required to provide invoices showing actual prices billed to the State. The State will also verify that the contracted prices match those which are included on the Contractor's online order guide.

Contractor shall return to the State all payments made under the contract for any audit exceptions. The Contractor agrees to correct immediately any pricing deviations discovered in the course of an audit.

ANNUAL USAGE

The quantities listed in the Estimated Usage column represent an estimated 12-month usage of all items to be used by all State Agencies. These are not to be construed as minimum or maximum quantities. The contract shall be for the actual quantities of each commodity ordered by or for any of the state facilities for shipment during the life of the contract. **The Nebraska Veterans Home-Scottsbluff is not included in this contract.** **NOTE: This contract may be utilized by all State Agencies.** Cycle menus may be available to the awarded vendor.

PRICES

Prices quoted shall be net, including transportation and delivery charges fully prepaid by the bidder, FOB Destination to the state facilities listed. Vendor shall not include any manufacturer's rebates in their bid. All manufacturers' rebates are to be paid directly to the State of Nebraska Facilities. Prices quoted shall be unit price as specified in UM column. Example, UM column states CS, unit price offered shall be Case Price. Extended price shall be unit price offered multiplied by Est. Qty. column. Where UM is listed as CS, product will be purchased by the case. Bidders shall quote the actual pack size of the product that is being offered for bid. If the pack size differs from the pack size specified in the Invitation to Bid, the bidder shall note the actual pack size in their bid response.

Where brand names are given, they are listed as guides only, unless otherwise specified. Where listed as "**NO SUBSTITUTE**," this is the only product that will be accepted. Vendor is required to list brand name bidding, manufacturer's product code number and color label being quoted. Vendor should attach a descriptive list of quality color codes that are being quoted. Prices offered herein shall be firm against any increase for the initial three (3) months of the contract. The State of Nebraska will not pay more than awarded contract price since this is part of the Special Bid Conditions.

Prices quoted on products that use NCP commodities shall show the price with and without the NCP discount.

Request for price increases shall be submitted to the State Purchasing Bureau 30 days prior to the end of each quarter of the contract. Request for price increases must be accompanied by documentation, either a percentage of an increase or a copy of an old invoice from supplier and a copy of a new invoice from supplier showing price differences. **NO price increases are to be billed to the state facilities without prior written approval by the State Purchasing Bureau. Price increase becomes effective with all orders placed on or after the effective date.** The State of Nebraska shall receive full proportionate benefits of price decreases immediately upon their effective date.

When submitting requests for price changes, vendor shall be required to list the State Item Number and Complete identification of items being changed. Documentation Invoices MUST show the state's item number.

QUALITY

Bids will be accepted on those items listed or approved by the State of Nebraska. In all items bid, the State shall be responsible for determining equivalency. The bidder will be held accountable for what is specified. The State reserves the right to test any alternate item bid, prior to awarding. Special Order Item: A special order item is defined as an item not currently on contract with the vendor but requested as a one-time purchase. The ordering facility will notify vendor three (3) weeks in advance for any special order items. These special order item(s) should be added on a separate sheet to be submitted with the regular order after having received pricing from the vendor. ALL NON-CONTRACT ITEMS MUST BE INVOICED SEPARATELY.

Fill Rates: Fill Rates for orders should be maintained at a 95% fill rate or higher and will be reviewed monthly. For purposes of this contract, fill rate will be defined as the total number of cases delivered divided by the total number of cases ordered. Pre approved substitutions for out of stock items will not be considered as filled for fill rate calculations.
