1.			This contract will be for one contractor. Subcontracting will not be allowed. There be a need for additional expertise on the Mountain Bike game, are we allowed to use a third party. Also for installation, are we allowed third party support?	The State anticipates that all work will be done by one contractor. However, we will accept proposals that include a subcontractor but the extent of the subcontractors' obligation must be noted in the RFP response. Interactive concepts were developed by NGPC staff through a process of visiting other nature centers, internet searches and in-house creativity.

This is our assumption, and that the contractor will actually build out all interactivity based on NGPC assets. - OR - does this mean the NGPC will be providing the finished interactive experience, and the contractor simply needs to ensure it is compatible with the hardware?	NGPC will be providing the following: Feature #1: NGPC will provide the text for the species text boxes, the images/pictures of each species. Feature #2: NGPC will provide GIS data in the form of REST map service, information about each amenity that will be included on the interactive map (restroom locations, trail difficulty, historical information, ADA capabilities, etc.). For both Features 1 & 2, the contractor will be building out the interactive software based on the information provided by NGPC.
