

Internet Explorer 7.0 Settings for NIS

Overview

Below are the settings needed for NIS to work properly with Internet Explorer 7.0 or higher. You may or may not be able to change these settings on your own, depending on your department's policies. Before making any changes on your PC be sure to check first with your local IT staff.

Settings

The settings you will need for Internet Explorer 7.0 are as follows:

- Allow all cookies from ne.gov
- Allow all pop ups from *.nis.ne.gov
- Enable File Download
- Enable automatic prompting for downloads
- Java permissions should be set to medium or lower
- Check for newer versions of stored pages
- Either the Java 2 JDK or the Microsoft Java JDK must be running

 Note: Internet Explorer 6.0 is packaged with Windows XP Professional. Users must apply SP1.


 NIS is not compatible with Microsoft Office 2007 or Windows Vista at this time.

The following are step by step instructions on how to make these settings.


Allowing Cookies

To allow cookies from ne.gov open Internet Explorer.


1. Click on **Tools** on the right hand side of the screen and then select **Internet Options** from the drop down menu.



2. Select the **Privacy** tab, and then click on the **Sites** button.




3. Type **ne.gov** in the **Address of website** field, and click on **Allow**. Then click **OK**.




Allowing Pop Ups

1. To allow pop ups click on the **Privacy** tab of Internet Options.




2. Make sure the **Turn on Pop-up Blocker** is unchecked and click **Apply**.




File Download & Automatic Prompting

To enable file downloads and the automatic prompting for downloads can be done at the same time.

1. Click on the **Custom level** button on the **Security** tab of Internet Options.



2. Scroll down to **Downloads**, and click on the **Enable** button for **Automatic prompting for file downloads** and for **File downloads**. Then click **OK**.




Java Permissions

1. To properly set your Java permissions click on the **Security** tab on Internet Options, and click on the **Custom level** button.




2. Scroll down to **Scripting**, and select **Enable** on **Active scripting** as well as on **Scripting of Java applets**. Then click **OK**.




Check for Newer Versions of Pages

Select the **General** tab on Internet Options.

Click on the **Settings** button under **Browsing history**.



Click on the **Automatically** option, and click **OK**.



Java 2 JDK / Microsoft Java JDK

Applying SP1 For Internet Explorer 6.0

Internet Explorer 6.0 is packaged with Windows XP Professional, and SP1 must be applied. See your local IT individuals for assistance.
