








Internet Explorer Settings Lesson

Step	Action
1.	Click the Tools button. 
2.	Click the Internet Options menu. 
3.	Click the Advanced tab. 
4.	Scroll down to the HTTP 1.1 settings .
5.	Make sure the “Use HTTP 1.1 though proxy connections ” box is checked.
6.	Scroll down to Security.
7.	Make sure the “Use SSL 2.0 ” box is checked.
8.	Click the Privacy tab. 
9.	Click the Sites button. 
10.	Enter “ *.ne.gov ” into the Address of website field.
11.	Click the Allow button. 
12.	Click the OK button. 
13.	Click the Settings button. 
14.	Enter “ *.ne.gov ” into the Address of website to allow field.
15.	Click the Add button. 
16.	Click the Close button. 
17.	Click the Security tab.

18.	Click the Trusted sites list item. 
19.	Click the Sites button. 
20.	Make sure the Require server verification (https:) for all sites in this zone box is not checked. 
21.	Click in the Add this website to the zone field. 
22.	Enter " *.ne.gov " into the Add this website to the zone field.
23.	Click the Add button. 
24.	Click the Close button. 
25.	Click the Custom level... button. 
26.	Scroll to Downloads .
27.	Make sure the Enable button for Automatic prompting for file downloads is selected. 
28.	Make sure the Enable button for File download is selected.
29.	Scroll down to Miscellaneous .
30.	Make sure the Enable button for Allow script-initiated windows without size or position constraints is selected.
31.	Make sure the Enable button is selected for Display mixed content . 
32.	Scroll to Scripting .
33.	Make sure the Enable button on Active scripting is selected.
34.	Make sure the Enable button for Scripting of Java applets is selected.
35.	Click the OK button. 
36.	If asked if you are sure you want to make these changes click the Yes button. 
37.	Click the General tab.

38.	Click the Settings button of the Browsing history. 
39.	Make sure Automatically under the Check for newer versions of stored pages is selected.
40.	Click the OK button.
