







## Internet Explorer 7.0 Settings Lesson

1.	<p>Click the <b>Tools</b> button.</p> 
2.	<p>Click the <b>Internet Options</b> menu.</p> 
3.	<p>Click the <b>Advanced</b> tab.</p> 
4.	<p>Scroll down to the <b>HTTP 1.1 settings</b>.</p>
5.	<p>Make sure the "Use <b>HTTP 1.1 though proxy connections</b>" box is checked.</p>
6.	<p>Scroll down to Security.</p>
7.	<p>Make sure the "Use <b>SSL 2.0</b>" box is checked.</p>
8.	<p>Click the <b>Privacy</b> tab.</p> 
9.	<p>Click the <b>Sites</b> button.</p> 
10.	<p>Enter "<b>ne.gov</b>" into the <b>Address of website</b> field.</p>
11.	<p>Click the <b>Allow</b> button.</p> 
12.	<p>Click the <b>OK</b> button.</p> 
13.	<p>Click the <b>Settings</b> button.</p> 
14.	<p>Enter "<b>ne.gov</b>" into the <b>Address of website to allow</b> field.</p>
15.	<p>Click the <b>Add</b> button.</p> 
16.	<p>Click the <b>Close</b> button.</p> 

17.	<p>Click the <b>Security</b> tab.</p> 
18.	<p>Click the <b>Trusted sites</b> list item.</p> 
19.	<p>Click the <b>Custom level...</b> button.</p> 
20.	<p>Scroll to <b>Downloads</b>.</p>
21.	<p>Make sure the <b>Enable</b> button for <b>Automatic prompting for file downloads</b> is selected.</p> 
22.	<p>Make sure the <b>Enable</b> button for <b>File download</b> is selected.</p>
23.	<p>Scroll down to <b>Miscellaneous</b>.</p>
24.	<p>Make sure the <b>Enable</b> button for <b>Allow script-initiated windows without size or position constraints</b> is selected.</p>
25.	<p>Scroll to <b>Display mixed content</b>.</p>
26.	<p>Make sure the <b>Enable</b> button is selected for <b>Display mixed content</b>.</p> 
27.	<p>Scroll to <b>Scripting</b>.</p>
28.	<p>Make sure the <b>Enable</b> button on <b>Active scripting</b> is selected.</p>
29.	<p>Make sure the <b>Enable</b> button for <b>Scripting of Java applets</b> is selected.</p>
30.	<p>Click the <b>OK</b> button.</p> 
31.	<p>If asked if you are sure you want to make these changes click the <b>Yes</b> button.</p> 
32.	<p>Click the <b>General</b> tab.</p> 
33.	<p>Click the <b>Settings</b> button of the Browsing history.</p> 
34.	<p>Make sure <b>Automatically</b> under the <b>Check for newer versions of stored pages</b> is selected.</p>

35.	<p>Click the <b>OK</b> button.</p> 
36.	<p>Click the <b>OK</b> button.</p> 
37.	<p><b>Warning:</b> Various changes to your PC, such as upgrading from Internet Explorer 6.0 to Internet Explorer 7.0, installing automatic updates, or reimaging can alter your Internet Explorer settings and consequently cause problems viewing PDFs through NIS.
