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Understanding Reports

NIS contains powerful tools that allow you to run and print reports. The system is flexible enough to allow you to change the data selected to print on a report.

Some reports print immediately while others remain in the system. You can manipulate print jobs that do not go straight to the printer in a variety of ways. When you run a report, the system submits it to a job queue. When the job finishes processing, you can:

- View the report online
- Navigate through the online report and copy information into another application
- Submit the report to the print queue for printing

The NIS Work Item Manager window helps you review a list of submitted reports. You can review information about a report that includes the report program number, the report version, the date it was submitted for processing, any errors, and whether the report ran successfully.
