F/A With No Attachment Integrity Overview

You can run the F/A With No Attachment Integrity Report to review and/or print if any of your assets which you marked as being split coded on the category codes are missing an actual split code attachment. If you have not entered a valid code on your category codes for Split Codes/Grants, this report will not help. The goal is to have this report blank. This means all your assets that have a value in Category Code 15 (Split Code/Grant) also have an attachment on the asset record. You can see a paperclip on that asset line. It does not check for accuracy of the attachment since it is free form text. The report will provide the following information:

- Agency
- Division
- Tag Number
- Asset Description
- Split Code/Grant


Procedure
