

NATURAL RESOURCES PLANNER TECHNICIAN

DESCRIPTION: Performs specialized professional work in the field of water resources planning; performs related work as required.

EXAMPLES OF WORK: (A position may not be assigned all the duties listed, nor do the listed examples include all the duties that may be assigned.)

Performs various technical tasks of moderate to high difficulty requiring knowledge and experience in a specific field.

Prepares assigned sections of technical reports and entire reports of a less complex nature.

Participates in plan formulation.

Supervises aides, draftsmen or professional people involved in technical work.

Responsible for coordination of assigned technical matters with federal, state and local agencies.

Makes occasional public appearances to explain program functions and policies.

Handles a minimum of administrative duties.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, ABILITIES, AND SKILLS REQUIRED: (These may be acquired on the job and are needed to perform the work assigned.)

ENTRY KNOWLEDGES, ABILITIES, AND SKILLS REQUIRED: (Applicants will be screened for possession of these through written, oral, performance, and/or other evaluations.)

JOB PREPARATION GUIDELINES: (Entry knowledge, abilities, and/or skills may be acquired through, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO, the following coursework/training and/or experience.)

Bachelor's degree in a field related to water resources planning plus four years of experience in the planning field.

SPECIAL NOTE

Receives general guidance in the performance of duties.
