

## MEDICAL TECHNOLOGIST

DESCRIPTION: Performs complex tests in medical laboratory for use in patient-care activities. Performs related responsible work as required.

EXAMPLES OF WORK: (A position may not be assigned all the duties listed, nor do the listed examples include all the duties that may be assigned.)

Assumes responsibility for and engages in Hematology procedures, including blood counts, reactions and typing.

Performs blood chemistry analysis, entailing the determination of the presence and amount of various substances in the blood.

Assumes responsibility for and engages in urinalysis procedures, to determine presence of various substances, reactions or pregnancy.

Engages in bacteriological procedures to determine presence, type and cause of bacteria in the body.

May perform related patient care services and tests.

May obtain necessary samples and specimens from patient for above tests.

Maintains records and inventory relative to above functions and prepares appropriate reports.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, ABILITIES, AND SKILLS REQUIRED: (These may be acquired on the job and are needed to perform the work assigned.)

ENTRY KNOWLEDGES, ABILITIES, AND SKILLS REQUIRED: (Applicants will be screened for possession of these through written, oral, performance, and/or other evaluations.)

JOB PREPARATION GUIDELINES: (Entry knowledge, abilities, and/or skills may be acquired through, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO, the following coursework/training and/or experience.)

Completion of college level training and certification as a Registered Medical Technologist after completion of required formal training.

Receives periodic review and consultation concerning progress of laboratory work.
