ITEMS

1. List any regulatory noxious weed experience you may have with a government regulatory agency.
2. List all work experience and/or coursework related to plant identification.
3. List all work experience and/or coursework related to making or recommending herbicide applications to control specific plants.
4. Specify if you are currently licensed as a commercial pesticide applicator in Nebraska and, if so, in which categories.

5. The person in this position must be able to share information and instruct or persuade others to adopt or apply acceptable weed control practices and regulatory requirements. Besides working one-on-one with individuals, a person in this position must be able to communicate with boards, such as county commissioners or weed control boards, and various groups. This person may also be required to do presentations at various meetings and assist with a public awareness campaign developed by the Department. Describe the experience or training you have had in interacting or meeting with others. Include any experiences in public speaking, providing instruction, or making presentations to groups. Be sure to emphasize any experience working with the public.
6. This position requires extensive use of county maps in preparation for and while conducting noxious weed investigations in a region consisting of 20 to 25 counties. The person in this position will be required to complete reports to document if compliance objectives are being met. Describe the experience or training you have had in conducting investigations, documenting compliance issues, and reporting those findings to individuals, groups, boards, and supervisors. Be sure to emphasize any experience working with maps or compliance objectives.
7. This position will require weekly overnight travel in-state as well as occasional out-of-state. This travel would include working with individuals and conducting inspections in a region as well as assisting other Department employees throughout the state. You would also be expected to attend and participate in meetings and conferences. Would you be willing to travel, including making overnight stays? If not, how do you propose to meet this requirement of the job?
