PURPOSE

Adobe Flash Player is a web browser plugin that is used in many of the systems on LINK. The guide below will walk through downloading and installing/updating the Adobe Flash Player plugin – the process is the same whether or not Flash is already installed. 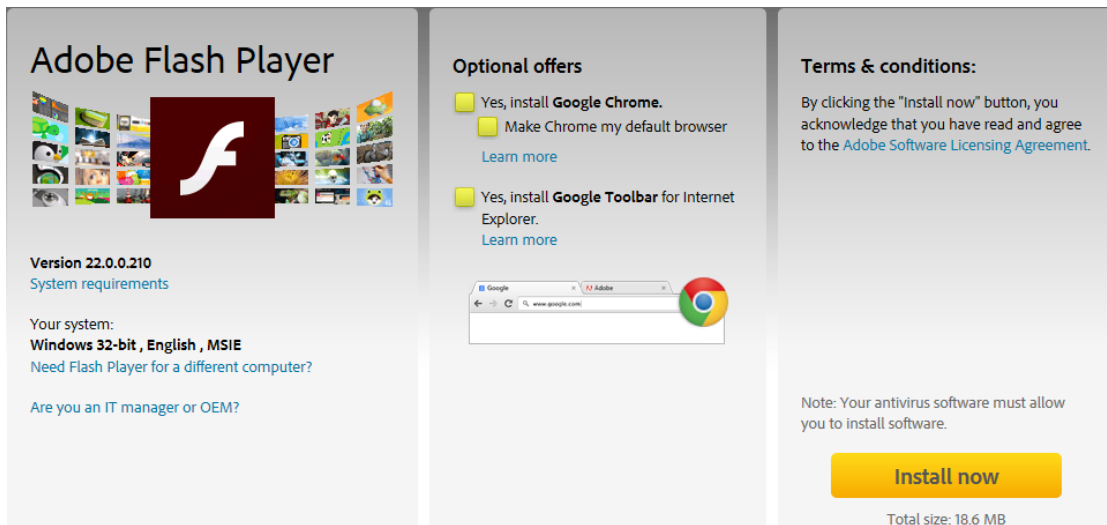

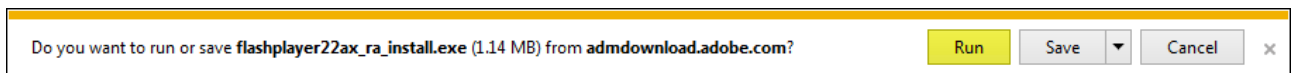
NOTE: Many State computers require administrative rights to install or update Adobe Flash. If you are not able to install or update Flash contact your IT support staff.

DOWNLOAD AND INSTALL/UPDATE ADOBE FLASH PLAYER

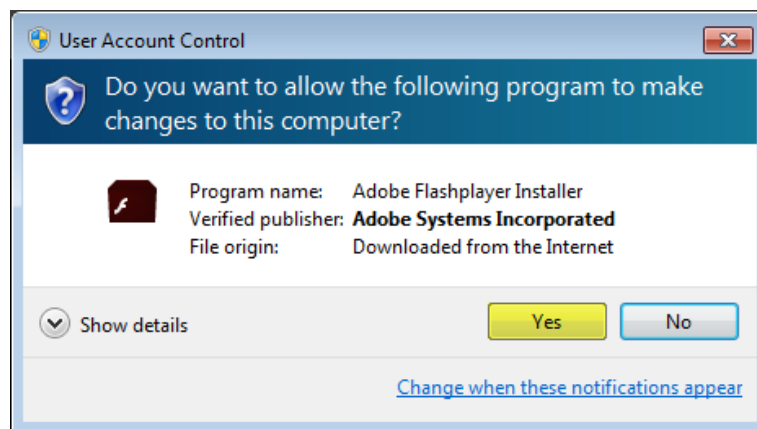
1. To download the Adobe Flash Player plugin go to this page: <https://get.adobe.com/flashplayer/>
2. Uncheck all of the Optional Offers listed on the page, then click the Install Now button:



3. The website will download the Flash installer; choose the option to Run or Open the installer (this generally appears at the bottom of the page but can vary depending on your web browser):



4. A prompt will appear prompting to run the Adobe Flash Player Installer; choose the Yes option:



5. The installer will run; you may receive a prompt to close Internet Explorer or any other web browsers you are using. If so, close the web browser and click the Continue button.
6. Once done, the installer will show that the installation is complete. Click the Finish button to close the installer.
7. Your web browser will open up to an Adobe page – to verify Flash is installed and the version visit the following link: <https://www.adobe.com/software/flash/about/>
The page will display what version of Flash Player is installed as well as list the latest version for most web browsers.
