RE: Debt Write-Off Procedures and Request for Write-Off

The State Claims Board will convene on December 2, 2015 at the State Capitol Building, 1445 K Street, Lincoln, NE, in Room 1524 from 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. to hear Miscellaneous claims for the waiver or cancellation of money or charges necessary for fiscal or accounting procedures, i.e. debt write-offs. If an agency, board or commission intends to submit a claim, please follow the procedures outlined below.

1. Each agency, board or commission shall submit one Claim Form for Injury or Damage for all write-offs. This will insure that each agency, board or commission is assigned one claim number.
2. Accompanied with the Claim Form shall be a Request for Write-Off form for each individual uncollectible debt. The Request for Write-Off form was designed to assist with reporting facts about the debt. Please add additional information as needed.
3. All claims for write-offs must be received by the Office of Risk Management by November 13, 2015.
4. Each agency, board or commission shall make arrangements to have an agency representative at the State Claims Board to discuss the claim.

The State Claims Board typically adjudicates claims during the hearing. Once the Board has acted, claims will be submitted to the Nebraska Legislature pursuant to the Miscellaneous Claims Act, Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 81-8,294 through 81-8,301. The claims will be divided into two bills, Claims Bill and Denied Claims Bill. The Bill numbers will be assigned once introduced to the Legislature.

Please remember to use one Request for Write-Off form for each individual uncollectible debt and only submit one Claim Form for Injury or Damage on behalf of the agency, board or commission. Claim forms and Request for Write-Off forms can be found on the Office of Risk Management's website, http://das.nebraska.gov/risk/claims_agency.html.
