
POLICY OF PROCEDURE

RE: Prioritization of Rural Allocations & Reduction of Agency General Fund Liabilities

As stewards of public funds, State government leaders have a responsibility for ensuring that public resources benefit all Nebraskans. With most state government operations concentrated in Lincoln, Nebraska, rural residents in our State often don't receive equitable government spending in their communities. Given the importance of a healthy economy and adequate government services in rural communities to Nebraska's statewide economic outlook, it is important that government leaders use their discretion to support rural Nebraska.

Consistent with longstanding practice, it shall be the policy of the Department of Administrative Services to support rural Nebraska by prioritizing Task Force for Building Renewal projects in rural communities. The enduring goal for the Department of Administrative Services Task Force for Building Renewal will be 65% of all project allocations will be awarded outside of the geographic boundaries of cities of the metropolitan and primary class. The financial resources allocated by the Task Force for agency renewal projects will be applied on a priority basis to offset current or future general fund liabilities to the State Budget.
