The almanac is a perfect example of a tool to help deliver effective, efficient, and customer-focused support and services for human resources operations within the State of Nebraska. Here are some of the highlights from this year's almanac:

- The turnover rate among state teammates decreased for professional staff from 14.9% to 9.7%
- Healthcare premiums for state teammates were kept flat for the first time since 2015
- Minority participation in the state workforce has increased over 71% since 2012

The State Personnel team handles and operates support and consultative services in all aspects of human resources operations including:

- Talent Acquisition and Retention
- Teammate Total Rewards, Recognition, and Engagement
- Performance Management
- Learning and Development
- Employee Relations and Collective Bargaining
