Habitat Improvement in Progress

This area is part of a statewide effort to improve upland habitat quality.
In an effort to improve the overall quality of grasslands...

- ...this area has been disked and interseeded with a mixture of legumes. These activities will increase plant diversity, create nesting cover, and promote annual weedy vegetation for years to come.
- ...this area has been treated with herbicides to control invasive plant species. This allows native plants to compete with invasive species and grow more vigorously.
- ...this area has been interseeded with native grasses, legumes, and forbs. This mixture of plants provides better nesting, brood rearing, and winter cover for many upland and grassland bird species.
- ...this area has had a prescribed burn conducted to stimulate native warm season grasses and forbs while stunting the growth of invasive plants.
