If we have misinterpreted the scope and, more of the economic analysis will be completed through other mechanisms outside of this project, we will gladly work with NEMA to narrow the scope and adjust our pricing accordingly. Our goal is to align with the State's needs and achieve the desired outcomes for this project. One additional area of note: the annual fee for access to the D&B data is \$96,000. This cost will need to be factored into the cost of the project if Nebraska doesn't not already have access to the D&B data.
