1.			The RFP references the "state" or "NDOL" several times in discussing the entity seeking proposals for this RFP. I would just like to clarify that the contracts associated with this RFP are with the Greater Nebraska Workforce Development Board and with the Greater Nebraska Chief Elected Officials Board and not with the Nebraska Department of Labor or the State of Nebraska?	<p>As stated in the RFP at Section V. Project Description and Scope of Work, Item A. Project Overview, "<i>The Nebraska Department of Labor (NDOL), on behalf of the Greater Nebraska Chief Elected Officials Board (GNCEOB) and Greater Nebraska Workforce Development Board (GNWDB), is soliciting competitive proposals to provide Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) services in the GNWDA [Greater Nebraska Workforce Development Area].</i>"</p> <p>The contract resulting from the RFP will be between the selected contractor and the Greater Nebraska Workforce Development Board and the Greater Nebraska Chief Elected Officials Board. The Nebraska Department of Labor will not be a party to such contract. Any terms or conditions in the RFP, including but not limited to, those in Section II. Terms and Conditions, Section III. Contractor Duties, and Section IV. Payment, which refer to the State of Nebraska or State and/or the Nebraska Department of Labor and/or NDOL shall instead refer to the Greater Nebraska Workforce Development Board and the Greater Nebraska Chief Elected Officials Board.</p>

Since the Administrative Entity is being included in this proposal, what would the role of the Nebraska Department of Labor be in working with that new Administrative Entity going forward after the contract is in place? Would this be the same way it works with the Greater Omaha and Greater Lincoln administrative entities?	<p>Other than limited transition activities (e.g. reasonable provision of copies of documents or agreements), the Nebraska Department of Labor's role will be limited to administration of WIOA Title I and Title III from the State perspective.</p> <p>Yes, the Department of Labor's role after the contract is in place will be similar to the way the Department of Labor works with the other local areas.</p>

A. 2. be revised to include the submittal of these two questions at the beginning of the Technical Approach response?</p>	<p>Item VI. A. 2 – Technical Approach should read as follows:</p> <p>The technical approach section of the Technical Proposal should consist of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Responses to Technical Approach Questions (Numbers 1 through 22) in Section V. D. Bidder Requirements b. Signed Assurances, Attachment E
4.	V. C.	29	<p>The RFP currently reads in paragraph 1, "<i>The initial term of the contract will run from the commencement of contract performance to June 30, 2020.</i>"</p> <p>Should this date read June 30, 2021?</p>	Yes, the date should read June 30, 2021.
