In most transmitter installations this is the norm.</p>	<p>Bidder is to provide ladder racking/cable trays and wall flange. Electrician will assist with installation.</p>
3.			<p>Will the electricians install the surge suppressors that are requested on both transmitters?</p>	Yes
4.			<p>Will the electricians install the transformer for the Main transmitter? Even if it's bid</p>	Yes
