Line 1 on the Invitation to Bid Page is asking for the price of the Articulated All Wheel Drive Loaders WITH Bucket already, and Line 2 on the Invitation the Bid Page is asking for the Bucket Price again along with the Quick Hitch?	Please see Section VII-Options Pages, Subsection A-Quick Hitch With Specified Bucket, number 1 and Section VI-Technical Specifications, Subsection H-Loader, Numbers 3 through 3.f. Line 1 on the ITB is the Core item. Per the above "Clarification of Options", line 2 is an Option.
11.	E. Tires	Pg. 30	the bid is calling for Michelin XTLA tires, Deere offers Michelin XHA2 from the factory. Is this acceptable? Thanks	No, NDOT does not accept the Michelin XHA2 tires.
