Light Disking & Interseeding Legumes

Light diskage is a conservation practice that involves turning over the top layer of soil to break up compacted soil and mix it with the underlying soil. This improves soil structure and allows for better water infiltration and root growth. Interseeding legumes involves planting legume seeds into the soil along with the existing vegetation. Legumes fix nitrogen in the soil, which improves soil fertility and promotes the growth of other plants.
