ITB & TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION REVISIONS

The following are revisions to the Specifications for the above mentioned ITB, 6559 OF. These revisions are to be considered as part of the ITB. It is the Bidder's responsibility to check the SPB website for all Addenda or Amendments.

- 1. Line 1 of the ITB is hereby replaced and superseded by:**
"MOTOR GRADER TO INCLUDE QUICK HITCH FRONT MOUNT"

- 2. Section VI, Subsection C, Number 2 is hereby replaced and superseded by:**
"Minimum of 175 net HP in First gear and minimum of 230 net HP in Top gear at a governed speed maximum 2500 RPM. Engine performance requirement to be in accordance with SAE J 1349 standard conditions."

- 3. Section VI, Subsection C, Number 4 is hereby replaced and superseded by:**
"Peak engine torque to be minimum 840 lbs."

- 4. Section VI, Subsection E, Number 1 is hereby replaced and superseded by:**
"Unit to be Tandem Drive with Autoshift"

- 5. Section VI, Subsection G, Number 1 is hereby replaced and superseded by:**
"Data sheet Stating base operating weight of unit with 14-foot moldboard and 14/00-R24 Michelin Sno-Plus tires (minimum of 36,100 lbs.). Base weight is to be without scarifier, ripper or other attached options."

- 6. Section VI, Subsection J, Number 4 is hereby replaced and superseded by:**
"Tires to be Michelin Sno-Plus 14.0 R24 Radial Tire. Any other tire bid, requires pre-approval by Fleet management prior to bid opening."
