**Questions and Answers**

No questions were received for ITB Number 6718 OF.

Section V, Subsection E. Paragraph 5 is hereby removed and replaced with the following:

The vendor shall set their bid price for the delivered commodity based on fuel prices for the month prior to the bid opening. During the term of the contract, for all orders placed, accommodations for changes in the retail price of fuel will be made for delivery from the shipping origin to the destination as follows: The Vendor must specify the origin of the product for each destination. If more than one origin is to be used for a destination, the one closest to the destination will be used for calculating the FCA. In the event that the origin changes during the contract period, the Vendor must furnish documentation to the state confirming such change. The state will be the sole judge as to the validity of the documentation. The origin will not be changed more than once per year. For the purpose of calculating the FCA in this contract, the following formulas and values will be used: The distance (di), from the origin to each destination (Di) will be established by the state. The approximate average fuel economy (E) will be 5 miles/gallon for all vendors and destinations. The calculated amount of fuel (Fi) used for delivery to each destination will be the distance divided by the fuel economy, rounded to the nearest gallon.

This Addendum will become part of the ITB and should be acknowledged with the ITB.
