Institutions of Higher Education subject to 2 CFR Part 200, Appendix III will allowed to utilize their approved Indirect Cost Rate.</p>
<p>Is the contractor expected to write draft policy and procedure, or simply make verbal recommendations to the NE Department of Education?</p>	<p>The contractor is expected to help develop up to three policies and procedures.</p>
<p>The instructions say, “provide assistance” Please clarify if a written draft of policy and procedures should be included as a deliverable.</p>	<p>A written draft of up to three policies and procedures should be provided.</p>
<p>The Cost Proposal is a little confusing.</p>	<p>Yes, it is. Thank you for catching this error. A revised description of the Cost Proposal has been posted.</p>
<p>Some costs do not seem to align with this specific project. For example, is the contractor expected to implement the Early Childhood Pyramid model?”</p>	<p>Costs should be provided for the major deliverables outlined in section V.E of the RFP using the excel template provided.
