**Prices submitted on the cost proposal form shall remain fixed for the first year of the contract. Any request for a price increase subsequent to the first year of the contract shall not exceed three percent (3%) of the previous Contract period. Increases will be cumulative across the remaining periods of the contract. Requests for an increase must be submitted in writing to the Department of Transportation a minimum of 30 days prior to the end of the current contract period. Documentation may be required by the State to support the price increase. The State reserves the right to deny any requested price increase. No price increases are to be billed to any State Agencies prior to written amendment of the contract by the parties.*
