1. **BID TABLE:** All Respondents are required to complete this attachment. Price quoted shall be a flat unit price per radio installation, per vehicle/equipment and shall include the following:
 - a. Labor required for radio installation
 - b. Miscellaneous materials to include, but is not limited to: screws, ties, sealers, etc.
 - c. Tools, instruments, and equipment needed to perform the installation
 - d. Removal of installation debris from vehicles
 - e. Travel to and from the installation location (including lodging if needed)
 - f. Standing Wave Ratio (SWR) testing and basic radio performance test
 - g. Rework due to any noncompliance with standard manufacturer procedures, failure to follow NDOT installation instructions or poor radio installation workmanship
