Proprietary/Confidential information is defined as trade secrets, academic and scientific research work that is in progress and unpublished, and other information which if released would give an advantage to business competitors and serve no public purpose (see Neb. Rev. Stat. § 84- 712.05(3)). In accordance with Attorney General Opinions 92068 and 97033, vendors submitting information as proprietary may be required to prove specific, named competitor(s) who would be advantaged by the release of the information and the specific advantage the competitor(s) would receive.
