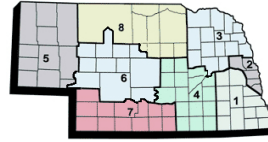

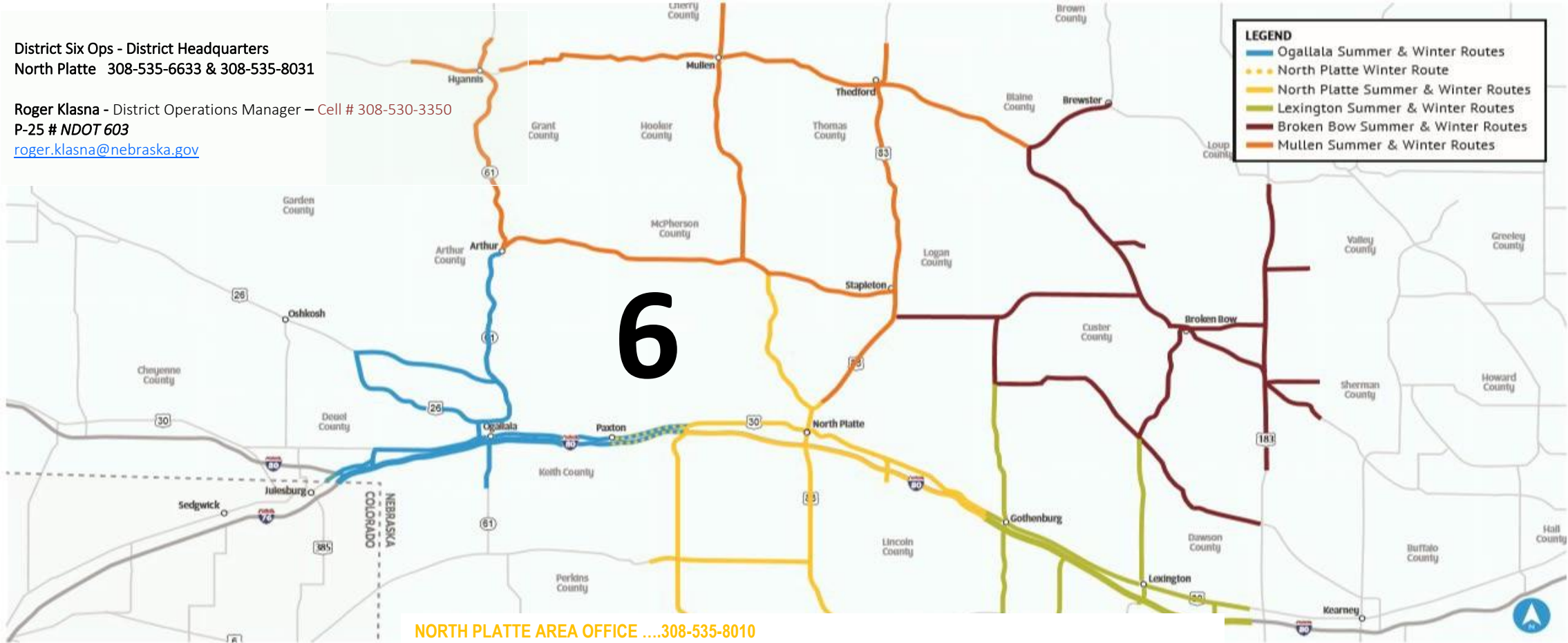

Incident Command – NDOT supports a unified command. Unified Command is an authority structure in which the role of incident commander is shared between agencies, each having authority in different roles for those responding. Unified command is one way to carry out command in which several responding agencies and/or jurisdictions share incident management

The regional Incident commanders for District Six are the Area Superintendents who represent NDOT and share the responsibility for incident management with their supervisors. Each are responsible for different highways, infrastructure, or geological areas. The regional group are known as the region incident command team who are to respond to a wide range of emergencies including wildfires, floods, dust storms, earthquakes, tornadoes, riots, spilling of hazardous materials, and other natural or human-caused incidents highway or infrastructure incidents.

Each Superintendent serves as the regions incident commander and commands the department’s response within their region. The superintendent is the decision-maker and has the responsibility and accountability to authorize and oversee closures, detours, deployment of resources and provide active roadway condition reports and 511 postings of traffic conditions or situations.

The Superintendent and his/her supervisors are the approving authority for use and deployment of the departments ITS elements, equipment, and personnel. Their authority includes message board deployment, activation, closure gate activation, command, and control in coordinating NDOT activities in Unified Command and Traffic Incident management.

The district uses a chain of command structure in its decision-making processes and as a standardized method of communication with orders, instructions, and information flowing down or up a clearly defined pathway.

The calling tree for Dispatch is – 1st - Area Superintendent (if no answer)

2nd - Area Supervisor
