Veterans' Hiring Preference

If you are a veteran, the spouse of a 100% disabled veteran, or the spouse of a service member currently on active duty or discharged within the past 180 days, you may be eligible for Veterans' Preference in the employment process. The opportunity to claim preference is presented during the application process, where you will be asked to submit verification.



DoD SkillBridge Program

If you are a transitioning service member, this program provides an opportunity to gain valuable civilian work experience through an individual internship with one of our participating State agencies during your last 180 days of service.
