

MAKE SURE YOUR MEDICATIONS ARE COVERED

Your pharmacy benefit plan may have had changes. Check prescription drug list NetResults Biosimilar Plus (PDL 25) to see if your medicines are covered.

What is a prescription drug list?

A prescription drug list (PDL) is a list of drugs covered by your pharmacy benefit. Your employer works with Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Nebraska and Prime Therapeutics (Prime) to help keep medications affordable. Prime manages your prescription drug list.

Your drug list is NetResults Biosimilar Plus (PDL 25)

This drug list was designed to help you get the most from your pharmacy benefit coverage.

When you use a drug from your prescription drug list, your copay (what you pay out of pocket) will usually be much lower. You can still fill prescriptions for drugs that are not on your plan's prescription drug list, but you will pay more out of pocket for the medication.

SEE IF YOUR DRUGS ARE COVERED:

- 1 Login to your online account via the web at **myNebraskaBlue.com** or through the Nebraska Blue app.
- 2 Click on *Pharmacy Benefits* to visit MyPrime.
- 3 Click *Medicine* and select *Find medicines* on the drop-down menu.
- 4 Type in the medication name.

If you don't have an online account, you may also visit **NebraskaBlue.com/DrugList** to download NetResults Biosimilar Plus (PDL 25) and use the search function to find your prescription.

If your medication isn't listed, talk to your doctor about switching to one of the drugs on the NetResults Biosimilar Plus (PDL 25) drug list that will work for you. That way, you won't pay more for your medication.
