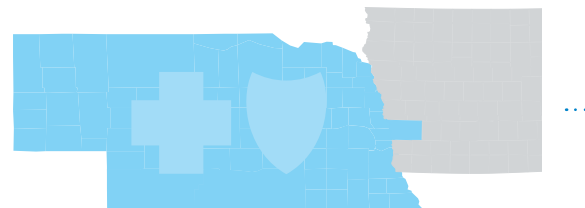
With three network options available, the choice is yours.

When you enroll in the Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Nebraska (BCBSNE) health plan your employer is offering, you can have peace of mind knowing you have access to a network of quality doctors, hospitals and other health care providers. BCBSNE offers three network options: **NEtwork BLUE**, **Premier Select BlueChoice** and **Blueprint Health**. Each provides access to quality providers, but with some differences.

NEtwork BLUE is a statewide network; Premier Select BlueChoice and Blueprint Health are regional networks within the state of Nebraska

NEtwork BLUE

NEtwork BLUE is made up of 98% of Nebraska's doctors and 99% of the state's non-governmental acute care hospitals.* That makes obtaining in-network care easy and convenient.

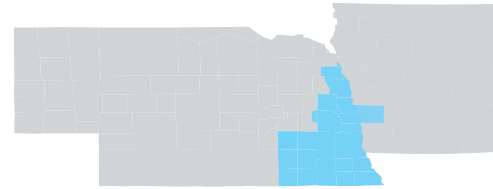

Our Premier Select BlueChoice network features Nebraska Methodist Hospital System and Nebraska Medicine. This regional network is available to groups headquartered in Omaha, Lincoln, Council Bluffs and the surrounding communities in ZIP codes starting with 515 (Pottawattamie county only), 680, 681, 683, 684 and 685. All other Nebraska providers are out-of-network.

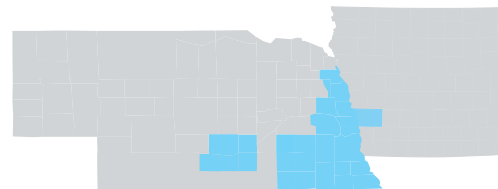

All other Nebraska providers are out-of-network.







Find a different network

Before receiving services, BCBSNE members should contact the provider and ask if the provider is in network with their specific network, e.g., NEtwork BLUE, Premier Select BlueChoice or Blueprint Health. Members may also verify the provider's network status by calling BCBSNE's Member Services department at the number on the back of their BCBSNE member ID card.



The Advantages of In-network Providers

In-network providers have agreed to accept our benefit payment for covered services as payment in full, except for any deductible, copays, coinsurance amounts and charges for noncovered services, which are your responsibility. This means that in-network providers, under the terms of their contract with us, can't bill you for amounts over our benefit allowance.

Please be aware that out-of-network providers can bill patients for amounts in excess of the amount payable under the contract.

In-network providers also file claims for BCBSNE members, meaning you have less paperwork to worry about. And as an additional time-saving convenience, we send our benefit payment directly to in-network providers.

Frequently Asked Questions

When deciding on a network, you may have some questions. We have the answers.

- Q** If I am receiving services from my current provider for pregnancy or another condition and I move to a regional network that my provider is not in it, may I finish the services with my current provider and have them covered as in-network?
- A** If you move to a regional network, your current provider will be out-of-network. If you are pregnant or receiving services for another condition and want to continue using your current provider, it may be best to wait until your group's next open enrollment period to decide whether or not to move to a regional network.
- Q** If there are no providers in the regional network who can perform a certain covered service for me, such as a transplant or other service, what are my options?
- A** If the network you select does not have in-network providers to cover transplants or other services, we may attempt to negotiate a claim specific rate. The negotiation is ideally done prior to services being performed. If our rate negotiation is successful, claims for that service will be processed using in-network cost shares, and we will pay the provider as in network. The provider will only charge for deductibles, coinsurance, copays and any non-covered items, if applicable. If our rate negotiation is unsuccessful, the out-of-network level of benefits will apply, and we will pay you. You will then be responsible for paying the provider.
- Q** What if I receive emergency services and the provider is out of network?
- A** Emergency services are processed at the in-network level of benefits. However, the out-of-network allowable amount applies. The provider could bill you for amounts in excess of the amount payable under your group's contract and you will be responsible for those amounts.
- Q** May I select a regional network option and continue seeing my current provider who is not in the regional network?
- A** Yes, but you will be subject to out-of-network cost shares. Your current provider could also bill you for amounts in excess of our out-of-network benefit allowance. Your provider may submit your claims to us for you, however some providers may make you file your claims. You may access a claim form at **NebraskaBlue.com/Forms**.
- Q** What if I choose a regional network and have a covered dependent living in Nebraska, but outside the service area?
- A** For covered services received outside the network's specific service area, benefits for emergency care will be covered at the in-network cost shares, subject to the out-of-network allowable amount. If your plan covers telehealth services, designated providers for urgent care services will be covered as in network. All other non-emergency services will be subject to out-of-network benefits. For non-emergency services, it's best to schedule services within your network's service area.
