

STATE OF NEBRASKA AUTO INSURANCE IDENTIFICATION CARD

**This card is only valid for those vehicles owned by the
State of Nebraska.**

THIS CARD MUST BE KEPT IN THE INSURED VEHICLE AND PRESENTED UPON DEMAND

Effective Dates: July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025

Under the provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 81-8,239.01 and 81-8,239.02, the State of Nebraska purchases excess insurance for property and crime, but is self-insured for automobile and a portion of any loss. If you believe you have suffered a loss, a claim may be filed with the State Claims Board and, if approved, will be paid from the State Tort Claims Fund or State Insurance Fund. The State retains all rights and immunities under the State Tort Claims Act, Neb. Rev. Stat. § 81-8,209 *et seq.*, and any other provisions of law.

What to do in case of an Accident

1. Obtain the following information:

Name, address and phone number of each driver, passenger and witness.

Name of insurance company and policy number for each vehicle involved.

2. To File A Claim:

The Agency involved in the accident, must complete the Vehicle Accident Report Form found on the Risk Management SharePoint portal. NRMA, the State's third-party administrator, will receive the claim and begin investigation.

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
